Crescent Parkway, Suite 300, Greenwood Village, Colorado. Mr. Gonzales reported that Schedio is working on a full reconciliation of all costs incurred to date to ensure accuracy within the reports.

Chairman Hopper reported that Schedio is also working on a reconciliation of the District and Authority costs for the Aurora Highlands Parkway project per the IGA between the parties. ARTA’s share is 42% and the District’s share is 58%. There will be a separate draw prepared for the October 14 meeting after the Schedio cost verification.

Engineer's Report and Verification of Costs No. 16 – Draw Request No. 27

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ENGINEER'S REPORT

INTRODUCTION

Schedio Group LLC ("Schedio Group") entered into a Master Service Agreement for Engineering Services ("MSA") with Aerotropolis Regional Transportation Authority ("ARTA") on December 11th, 2018. Task Order 01 AACMD/ARTA - Cost Verification, was approved on December 19, 2018. This report is Schedio Group's sixteenth deliverable associated with Task Order 01 of the MSA.

The Intergovernmental Agreement Among the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Adams, The City of Aurora and The Aerotropolis Area Coordinating Metropolitan District Establishing The Aerotropolis Regional Transportation Authority dated February 27, 2018 ("IGA") states:

"Capital Plan" means the detailed phasing plan and budget attached hereto as Exhibit D (of the IGA) for the regional capital improvements to be funded by the Authority and incorporated into the Regional Transportation System, including the estimated costs associated with the planning, design, financing, permitting, construction, inspection and acceptance for maintenance of such improvements."

Schedio Group has confirmed that costs verified in this Engineer's Report and Verification were anticipated by the IGA and associated Capital Plan and are therefore authorized to be paid for by ARTA.

See the IGA for additional information related to the cost splits agreed upon between Aerotropolis Area Coordinating Metropolitan District ("AACMD") and ARTA, project locations, etc.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

Schedio Group reviewed invoices and pay applications totaling \$920,160.74 associated with Draw 27. Schedio Group finds that the entire **\$920,160.74** reviewed is associated with the design and construction of Public Improvements as anticipated by the IGA and is therefore authorized to be paid for by ARTA. To date, Schedio Group has verified \$10,270,455.64 associated with Draws 1-27. For details, see *Figure 1 – Summary of Costs Reviewed by Job Code* and *Exhibit A – Summary of Costs Reviewed by Vendor*.

VERIFICATION OF COSTS

Schedio Group reviewed soft, indirect and hard costs. Schedio Group found costs associated with Public Improvements to be reasonable when compared to similar projects, during similar timeframes in similar locales.

VERIFICATION OF PAYMENTS

The District Accountant is responsible for verification of proofs of payments.

VERIFICATION OF CONSTRUCTION

Schedio Group LLC performed a site visit on September 24, 2020. Observation of the constructed improvements was performed to ensure that Public Improvements are being constructed in general conformance with the approved construction drawings. Photos are available from Schedio Group LLC upon request.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES AND NOTABLE METHODOLOGIES

Various job code changes were implemented between Draw 26 and Draw 27. These job code changes were determined by others (developer, program manager, construction manager, etc.). Schedio Group was not involved in determining the job code changes. Schedio Group has incorporated the job code changes into Draw 27, therefore amounts herein reflect the job code changes. As a result of the job code changes, verified dollar amounts have, in some cases, shifted from one job code (project segment) to another job code (project segment), which in turn appears to have increased ARTA’s financial obligation per the following agreements:

- Intergovernmental Agreement Among The Board Of County Commissioners Of The County Of Adams, The City of Aurora And The Aerotropolis Area Coordinating Metropolitan District

Establishing The Aerotropolis Regional Transportation Authority, prepared by McGeady Becher P.C. and dated February 27, 2018

- Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Design and Construction of The Aurora Highlands Parkway Among Aerotropolis Area Coordinating Metropolitan District and Aerotropolis Regional Transportation Authority, prepared by McGeady Becher P.C. and dated August 12, 2020

Schedio Group has not yet had an opportunity to review the job code changes and therefore verified amounts associated with Draws 1-27 are subject to revision. For details, see *Exhibit A – Summary of Costs Reviewed by Vendor*.

ENGINEER'S VERIFICATION

Timothy A. McCarthy, P.E. / Schedio Group LLC (the Independent Consulting Engineer) states as follows:

The Independent Consulting Engineer is an engineer duly qualified and licensed in the State of Colorado with experience in the design, construction and verification of costs associated with the design and construction of Public Improvements of similar type and function as those described in the above Engineer's Report.

The Independent Consulting Engineer has reviewed applicable construction and legal documents made available by others related to the Public Improvements under consideration to state the conclusions set forth in this Engineer's Verification.

The Independent Consulting Engineer finds and determines that Public Improvements considered in the attached Engineer's Report dated September 24, 2020 were contemplated by the Intergovernmental Agreement Among The Board Of County Commissioners Of The County Of Adams, The City of Aurora And The Aerotropolis Area Coordinating Metropolitan District Establishing The Aerotropolis Regional Transportation Authority, prepared by McGeady Becher P.C. and dated February 27, 2018 and are therefore authorized to be paid for by The Aerotropolis Regional Transportation Authority, and that the values associated with soft, indirect and hard costs associated with the design and construction of Public Improvements as of , September 17, 2020 (date of Draw Request 27) are reasonably valued at **\$920,160.74**.

In the opinion of the Independent Consulting Engineer, the above stated value for soft, indirect and hard costs associated with the design and construction of the Public Improvements is reasonable and consistent with costs of similar improvements constructed for similar purposes during the same timeframe and similar locales and is eligible for AACMD Lender reimbursement.
