These items change based on what your municipality has contracted the local recycler to collect and the technology employed by the local recycler. This differs from city to city, state to state. Please contact your local recycler for the exact information on what is accepted in your specific location.

RECYCLING ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Aluminum cans
- Brown paper bags
- Cardboard
- Catalogs, magazines and phone books
- Chipboard (cereal boxes, shoe boxes, etc.)
- Colored paper
- Computer paper
- Envelopes
- Glass bottles and jars
- Newspapers and junk mail
- Plastic bottles and jugs
- Tin and steel cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- White ledger paper

RECYCLING NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Aluminum foil
- Auto glass or ceramics
- Batteries
- Film canisters
- Light bulbs
- Painted wood
- Paper towels
- Plastic grocery bags (Please return to your supermarket)
- Plastic wrap
- Porcelain
- Styrofoam
- Treated wood
